USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY

- Out of bounds: white stakes, paved roads and fences constitute boundaries of golf course
- · Regular water hazards: vellow stakes or lines
- Lateral water hazards: red stakes or lines
- Perimeter wetlands: treated as a lateral hazard
- Waste areas: players may ground club without penalty
- All "staked" areas around newly planted trees are to be played as ground under repair
- Yardages are marked to the center of the green
- Be sure to fill divots, repair ball marks and rake bunkers
- Please use cart paths where available
